

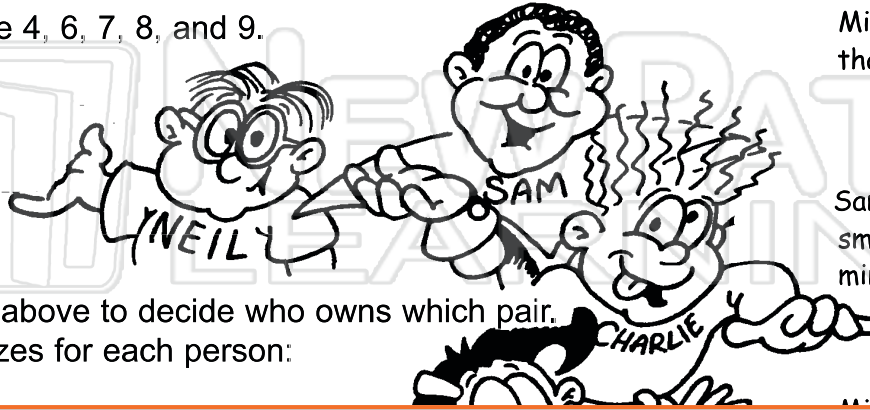

Mine are larger than Neil's.

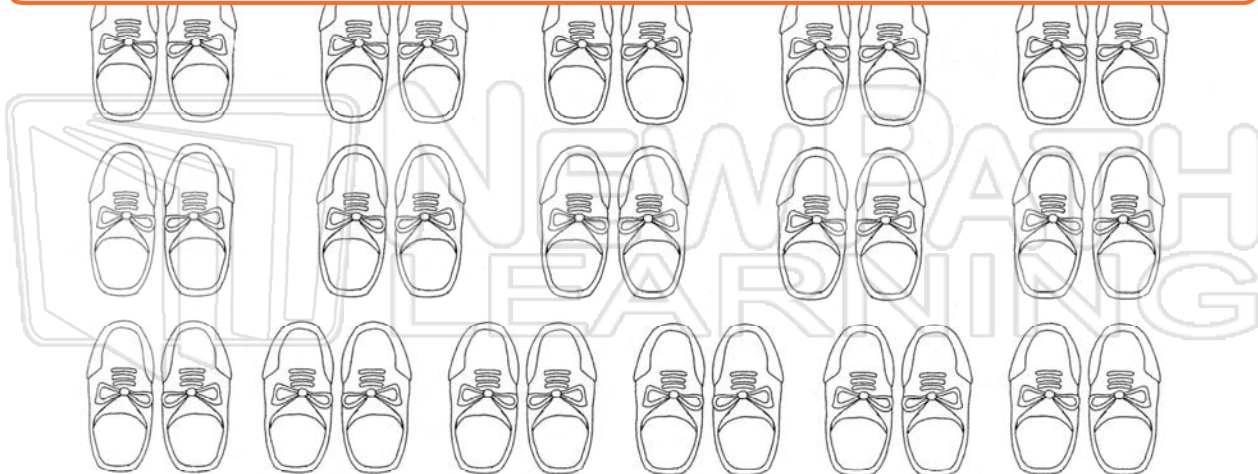
