


HIV Progression



Stages of HIV Infection

Without treatment, HIV infection advances in stages, getting worse over time. HIV gradually destroys the immune system and eventually causes **Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome** (AIDS).



In addition to other general health tests, blood tests will be used to monitor a patient with HIV infection. These test results will help the health care provider decide whether they should make changes to a patient's treatment.

You want your CD4 count to be HIGH

CD4 Cell Count

CD4 cells are specialized cells that destroy HIV. The higher the CD4 count, the healthier your immune system.

CD4 cells

Also called an HIV RNA test, tracks how many HIV particles are in a sample of blood.


