What is an Abbreviation?

An abbreviation is a shortened form of a longer word.

Here are some abbreviations you should know: Notice that every abbreviation starts with a capital and ends with a period.

- Mr. - Mister
- Mrs. - Missus or Missis (The longer forms are no longer used)
- Ms. - pronounced mizz
- Dr. - Doctor
- Jan. - January

- EPA - Environmental Protection Agency
- FBI - Federal Bureau of Investigation
- MLB - Major League Baseball
- NFL - National Football League
- NOW - National Organization for Women
- TBA - to be announced
