What is an Abbreviation?

An abbreviation is a shortened form of a longer word.

Here are some abbreviations you should know: Notice that every abbreviation starts with a capital and ends with a period.

- Mr. Mister
- Mrs. Missus or Missis (The longer forms are no longer used)
- Ms. pronounced mizz
- Dr. Doctor
- Jan. January

- USA United States of America
- ABC American Broadcasting Company
- AFC American Football Conference
- ASAP as soon as possible
- ATM Automatic Teller Machine
- DC District of Columbia
- DOT Department of Transportation
- EPA Environmental Protection Agency
- FBI Federal Bureau of Investigation
- MLB Major League Baseball
- NFL National Football League
- NOW National Organization for Women
- TBA to be announced



Some abbreviations are just lower case letters without any periods.

- mph miles per hour
- cm centimeter
- Ib pound
- mo month
- wk week
- in inch
- yd yard
