How do you add the ING suffix to verbs?

We add <u>-ing</u> to many verbs. But to spell them correctly, you need to remember the rules. Here are some rules to help you.

1. Usually just add the <u>ing</u> at the end of a verb. Example: walk - walking, sing - singing, sail -sailing

2. If the verb ends in silent <u>e</u>, drop the <u>e</u> then add -<u>ing</u>. Example: hope - hoping, take - taking

3. If the verb has a short vowel and ends in one consonant, double the constant of the constan
