

CONTRACTIONS

What are Contractions?

A contraction is a special word made by putting together a verb and another word. Every contraction has an apostrophe to show where letters are missing from the original two words.

Example: is + not = isn't

Notice that the words are put together but the o is gone.

Look at each contraction to see how the words are put together. An apostrophe shows where a letter is missing:

- 1. What is the contraction for does + not? doesn't or does'nt
- 2. What is the contraction for are + not? aren't or aren't
- 3. What two words made the contraction don't?
- 4. What two words made the contraction she'll?
