What is a Suffix?

A suffix is a letter or group of letters added to the end of a word to change its meaning.

To change a word from singular to plural, you add the suffix -s or -es.

Examples: boy - boys box - boxes


To change from present to past tense, you add the suffix -ed.

Examples: color - colored
