## What are Consonant Blends?

Consonant blends are two or more letters that work together. When a word is sounded out, both of the letters in a consonant blend are heard. For example, in the word small, the $\mathbf{s}$ and the $\mathbf{m}$ are blended together in sounding out the sm.
