

## R-CONTROLLED VOWELS

### What are R-Controlled Vowels?

**R-controlled vowels** are vowels in which the **r** following the vowel changes the sound of the vowel. Sometimes, we call the **r** a *bossy letter* because it *takes over* and *bosses* the vowels around!

#### Examples

- 1] In the word car, the **r** following the vowel **a** changes or controls the vowel sound.
- 2] In the word bird, the **r** following the vowel **i** changes or controls the vowel sound.
- 3] In the word purse, the **r** following the vowel **u** changes or controls the vowel sound.
