


# SIMPLE SUBJECT AND PREDICATE OF A SENTENCE

## What are the Subject and the Predicate of a Sentence?

The **subject** of a sentence is **who** or **what** the sentence is about. The **predicate** of a sentence is the **doing** or **action** part of the sentence. The predicate tells us what the subject of the sentence is doing.

### Example Haley sat down at her computer.
