It is important to use the correct punctuation when writing.

Some punctuation marks include...

Period Looks like this .
Used at the end of a sentence and in abbreviations.

Examples: The dog ran up the stairs.
An abbreviation for February = Feb.

When writing a proper name, don't forget the PERIOD.

When writing a date, don't forget the COMMA.

February 14, 2013
May 4, 1998
Sunday, June 29, 2003

If you use an abbreviation, don't forget the PERIOD.

When writing an address, don't forget the COMMA.
