What is the Main Idea?

The main idea is the overall theme of a paragraph or section of a text.

Example:

Mary loves to read more than anything else. She reads before and after school. She also reads during lunch time and even on the playground. All she asks for her birthday is...books!

The main idea of this paragraph is that Mary loves to read.
