

MAKING PREDICTIONS

When you make a **prediction**, you make a reasonable guess about what is going to happen <u>NEXT</u> in the story.

You should use the hints and clues the author writes in the story in order to make an educated prediction.

Example:

According to her brother Aiden, Sarah was a tattle tail. No matter what Aiden did, Sarah always told on Aiden. One day, Sarah and Aiden were building large towers out of blocks. Aiden accidentally knocked down Sarah's tower.
