

AUTHOR'S PURPOSE

The *Author's Purpose* is the reason that the author wrote the piece.

Some purposes for writing include:

- Inform
- Entertain
- Persuade
- Create a mood

If the author's purpose is to **inform**, he/she plans to **teach** the reader.

If the author's purpose is to **entertain**, he/she plans to **amuse** the reader.

If the author's purpose is to **persuade**, he/she plans to **convince** the reader to believe his/her point of view.

If the author's purpose is to **create a mood**, he/she plans to use much description to **stir** emotions.
