

SUBJECT AND VERB AGREEMENT

What Is Subject and Verb Agreement?

- Whether a word is **singular** or **plural** is called its **number**. In a sentence, the **subject** and the **verb** must **agree** in number.
Singular subject = **singular** verb
Plural subject = **plural** verb
- The **subject** of a sentence is **not** found in the prepositional phrase.
 The **coach**, along with the soccer players, **is** celebrating. The subject of the sentence is **coach**, not soccer **players**, so the subject is **singular**.
- **Compound subjects** contain **more than one** noun or pronoun.
 When compound subjects are joined by the word **and**, the verb will be **plural**. When compound subjects are joined by the words **or** or **nor**, the
