## What Is a Verb?

A verb is the part of speech that expresses action or state of being.

## Examples:

- There are **two** types of verbs: **action verbs** (ran, jumped) and **linking verbs** (is, was). A linking verb is also called a **verb of being**.
- A transitive verb has an object, while an intransitive verb does not have an object.
- A **verb phrase** is made up of a verb and one or more helping verbs.
- Two verbs joined by a conjunction are called a compound verb.
