

## **GERUNDS, INFINITIVES, PARTICIPLES**

#### What is a Gerund?

A **gerund** is a **verb** that is used as a **noun**. A **gerund** is formed by adding *-ing* to the **present** form of a **verb**.

Examples: The gerunds in the following sentences are in bold print

- Studying is mandatory before an important test.
- o My father enjoys cooking for our family.

## What is an Infinitive?

An **infinitive** is a **verb** that is used as a **noun**, **adjective**, or **adverb**. The word *to* is known as the **sign of the infinitive**.

**Examples:** The **infinitives** in the following sentences are in **bold print**.
