What is Reading Rate?

Reading rate is the **speed** at which a person reads a particular text. A person needs to determine the **purpose** for reading before he/she chooses a reading rate.

Purposes of Reading

- Scanning: reading to find a specific fact or detail
- Skimming: reading to get an overview of the text
- Reading for comprehension: demands careful, thoughtful reading from the student, and rereading may be required
- Reading for enjoyment: may be done quickly, and rereading is not usually required
