What is the Commutative Property?

- The Commutative Property is used in addition.
- Commutative Property is when a number sentence is turned around and it still means the same thing.

How to Figure Out Commutative Property Problems:

- Using the Commutative Property, it can be said that $3 + 2 = 5$ is the same as $2 + 3 = 5$. This means that $3 + 2 = 2 + 3$. No matter which way the 2 and the 3 sit, the answer remains the same.
