What are Ordinals?

- An ordinal is an object's position in the order of a group.
- An ordinal tells whether an object is first or fifth.
- Ordinals go as follows:
 one = first
 two = second
 three = third
 four = fourth
 five = fifth
 six = sixth
 seven = seventh
 eight = eighth

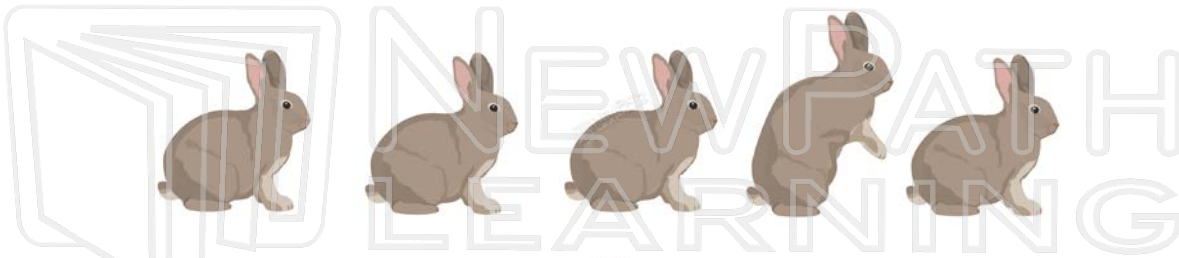

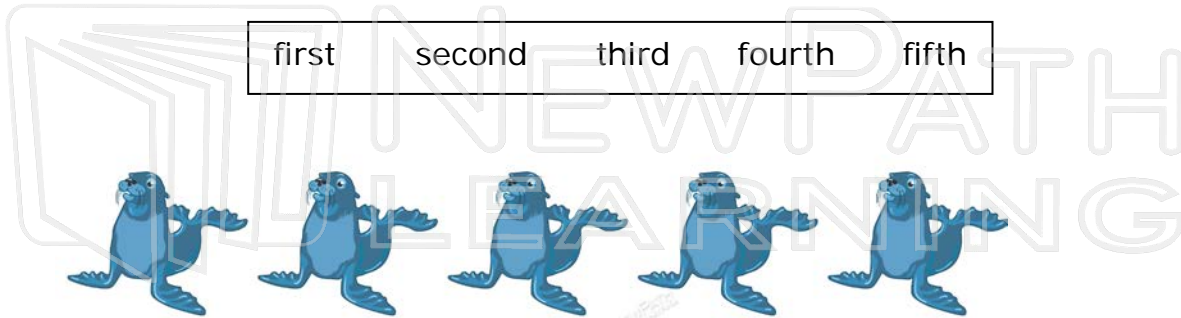
In this set of penguins, the penguin that is waving is the 3rd (third) penguin in line.



In this set of rabbits, you will see they are facing the other way. The rabbit that is standing up is 2nd (second) in line.
