## What is a Number Line?

- Number lines can be used to help with many different ways.
- The most common ways are for addition and subtraction.

How to Use a Number Line for an Addition Problem:

- When using a number line for an addition problem, start by putting your finger on the first number of the problem.

$$

4+2= \\
\leftarrow 0-1-2-3-\underline{\mathbf{4}}-5-6-7-8-9-10 \rightarrow
\end{gathered}
$$

How to Use a Number Line for a Subtraction Problem:

- When using a number line for subtraction, you will move to the left. The numbers should get smaller.
