


ORDINAL NUMBERS



The **bold**, <u>underlined</u> words above are called **ORDINAL** numbers.

Ordinal numbers tell the **position** of someone or something.

More Examples of Ordinals:

If there are five people in front of you in line, you are the **SIXTH** person in line.

If there are six people in front of you in line, you are the **<u>SEVENTH</u>** person in line.

If there are seven people in front of you in line, you are the **<u>EIGHTH</u>** person in line.

If there are eight people in front of you in line, you are the **<u>NINTH</u>** person in line.

If there are nine people in front of you in line, you are the **<u>TENTH</u>**
