## What Is the Associative Property?

Associative Property of Addition explains that when three or more numbers are added, the sum is the same regardless of the order in which the numbers are grouped and/or added.

For example: (1 + 2) + 3 = 1 + (2 + 3)

## How to use the associative property of addition:



or

6 + (5 + 7) = 6 + 12 = 18

which shows that both groupings leads to the same sum.

The **Associative Property** is helpful when adding several numbers. It also makes mental math easier.
