## What Is Estimation?

When you make an estimate, you are making a guess that is approximate. This is often done by rounding.

## How to Estimate:

- When estimating, you will often need to round off the numbers with which you are working.


## For example:

There are 148 gumballs in three jars. If the jars have about the same


To estimate the sum of 23 and 17:
o First round 23 and 17 to the nearest ten.
23 rounded to the nearest ten is 20
17 rounded to the nearest ten is 20
o Then add 20 and 20 together. $20+20=40$

To estimate the difference between 32 and 14:
o First round 32 and 14 to the nearest ten.
32 to the nearest ten is 30
14 to the nearest ten is 10
o Then subtract 10 from 30 . $30-10=20$
