

COMPARING AND ORDERING NUMBERS

What Is Comparing and Ordering Numbers?

- Ordering numbers means listing numbers from least to greatest, or greatest to least.
- **Comparing** numbers means looking at the values of two numbers and deciding if the numbers are *greater than, less than,* or *equal to* each other.
- Two symbols are used in comparing numbers:
 (less than) and > (greater than).



Compare two numbers and decide if they are less than, greater than, or equal to each other.

Example: 57 > 32 68 < 90 LEARNING
