## COMPARING AND ORDERING NUMBERS

## What Is Comparing and Ordering Numbers?

- Ordering numbers means listing numbers from least to greatest, or greatest to least.
- Comparing numbers means looking at the values of two numbers and deciding if the numbers are greater than, less than, or equal to each other.
- Two symbols are used in comparing numbers: $<$ (less than) and > (greater than).


Compare two numbers and decide if they are less than, greater than, or equal to each other.

## Example: $57>32$

$68<90$
