## Writing Whole Numbers

Use a comma to separate each group of three digits.

## Examples:

3, 107, 527
439,802
4,082

## Reading Whole Numbers



## You read the above number:

Three million, one hundred forty-seven thousand, five hundred twentysix

NEVER use the word AND when reading or writing a whole number.

## For example:

## For the number 321:

We write:
321

We read:
three hundred twenty-one

We DO NOT read: three hundred and twenty one
