Forces make things move!

A force is a push or pull that can make something move.

You use force to open a window.

You use force to do other things too, such as:

- push open a door
- throw a basketball through the hoop
- push a friend on a swing.

Speed

Speed is how fast or how slow an object moves.

If you push something with A LOT of force it might go very fast. Example: if you push a toy car on a wood floor, it will go very fast across the floor.

If you use less force to push the toy car, it will move slower across the floor.


