What is Weather?


When someone asks, "What is the weather today?" you know what they are asking. They are asking what it is like outside. They want to know what nature is doing in your area – raining, snowing, blowing...


Thermometers have numbers. The numbers tell us if the temperature is hot or cold.

How Clouds Form


There is something called **water vapor** that is in the air.

Rain falls from clouds in the sky.




Snow falls from clouds in the sky when it is really cold outside.
