What Do Plants Need to Stay ALIVE?

What Do Animals Need to Stay ALIVE?


Animals need air, water, food, and a place to live. A **shelter** is a safe place for an animal to be

How do people grow and change?

People and animals grow from a baby to an adult.

How do animals grow and change?

Some animals look like their parents when they are born, like a puppy.





Life Cycle of a Frog

A frog's life cycle starts with an egg too.



A seed needs four special things in order to grow into a new plant:

- Water
- Warmth from the Sun
- Air
- Room to grow



How Does a Seed Grow?

- 1. The seed is planted and gets enough water and room to grow.
- 2. A small root grows down into the soil from the seed.
- 3. Then, the stem grows up toward the top of the soil. Then the stem breaks through the soil as it grows. When the stem grows and begins to develop leaves, it is called a **seedling**.
- 4. Then it grows into an adult plant.
