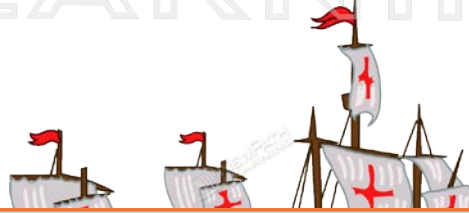


FAMOUS EXPLORERS

Who were the Famous Explorers?

- **Christopher Columbus (1451-1506):** Italian explorer
 - He was sent by King Ferdinand & Queen Isabella of Spain.
 - He took the *Nina*, the *Pinta* and the *Santa Maria* as his ships.
 - He came to an island he named San Salvador.

- Named the Pacific Ocean (Pacific means "peaceful")
- He died on the journey, but his crew made the first trip around the world.
- **Sir Francis Drake (1540-1596):** English explorer
 - Robbed a ship to get lots of silver and other prizes
- **Jacques Cartier (1491-1557):** French explorer
 - Explored parts of Canada, and named a mountain "Mont-real".
- **Samuel de Champlain (1567-1635):** French explorer
 - Discovered a lake that was over 100 miles long. It was named after him.
- **Henry Hudson (1565-1611):** English explorer
 - Was trying to find the Northwest Passage
 - Explored a large river going north. It was later named after him.

- **Lewis & Clark:** U.S. explorers
 - President Jefferson chose them to explore the new land of the Louisiana Purchase.
 - Sacagawea helped them cross the Rocky Mountains to get to the Pacific Ocean.
