3. **inflammation** as a first response to injury



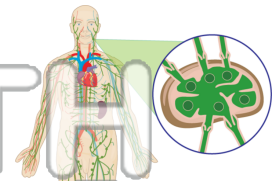

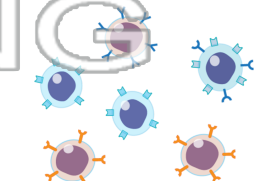
