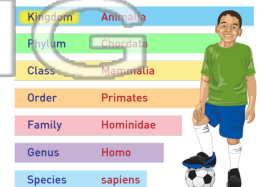

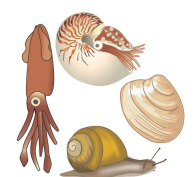

4. **hyphae** - long, thin, branching structures of multicellular fungi

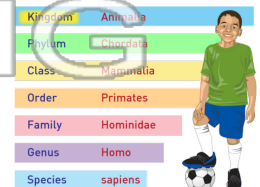
5. **insect** - animal with a pair of antennae, six legs, and a segmented body
