3. **immunity** against pathogens

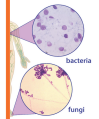

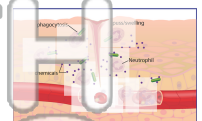

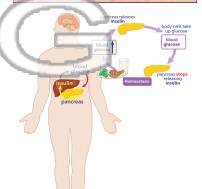
